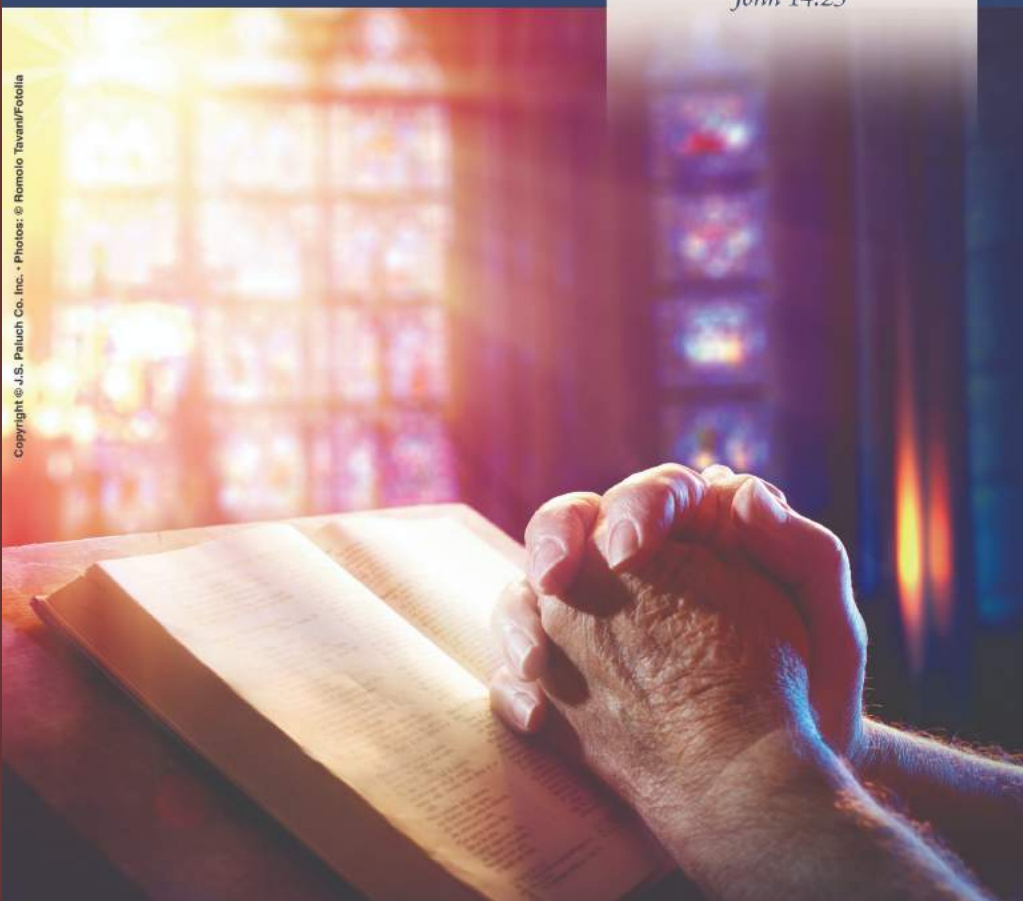

## From the Pastor...

.My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The early Church had its problems... much as we do today. The biggest problem stemmed from the admission of the Gentile community. Since Jesus was a Jew, as were almost all of the early followers, disciples and apostles, they followed all the Jewish laws and regulations, while still believing in Jesus, the Messiah. It stood to reason that they would also expect everyone to be like them and do the same. To be a follower of Jesus would mean that you would also follow the laws and practices of the Jewish faith.

Paul did not see it that way and when Paul went out converting Gentile communities to the Christian faith, he did not have them follow the precepts of the Jewish law, which would involve circumcision, particular apparel, practices, purity regulations regarding food, cleanliness, and so on.

According to our first reading today, Paul had quite a debate and argument with them but neither side would give in. It was decided that Paul and Barnabas would go to Jerusalem and settle the problem once and for all. This was probably the first Council of the Church and it did indeed resolve the issue in a compromise.

We settle debates much in the same way in the Church today, and that is why Councils like Vatican II were and are so important. It is the Spirit working through the whole Church, as One Who is able to influence things or change things and create oneness in the Church.

That oneness is also the subject of Jesus' prayer in the Gospel today. Jesus prays that all may be one, the original followers and those who will come after. The deep theological prayer here is spelled out with logic. Since the Father and the Son are one, the Father is in the Son and the Son in the Father. Jesus prays that we may also be one with the Father and Son ... in other words, that we be of one mind with Them, that we share in Their glory and in Their love.

The root of Christianity is love. You will be judged on how well and how much you have loved. I think we can be easily forgiven faults, but the great issue is how much we bear Christ's love into our world. If we have learned anything from this Easter season, let us know that God raised and glorified his Son to let us know that we can be raised and glorified as well. And Jesus' prayer today tells us how.

Can we begin to measure our days by how much we have loved and shown love? It is a challenge. It is Christianity. It is Jesus' prayer for us. It is Good News... if only we will live it!

I wish you and your family a blessed week ahead.

## Desde el Escritorio del Párroco

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

La Iglesia primitiva tuvo sus problemas... tanto como los tenemos hoy. El mayor problema surgió de la admisión de la comunidad gentil. Ya que Jesús era judío, al igual que casi todos los primeros seguidores, discípulos y apóstoles, siguieron todas las leyes y regulaciones judías, mientras seguían creyendo en Jesús, el Mesías. Era lógico que también esperaran que todos fueran como ellos y hicieran lo mismo. Ser un seguidor de Jesús significaría que también seguirías las leyes y prácticas de la fe judía.

Pablo no lo vio de esa manera y cuando Pablo fue convirtiendo a las comunidades gentiles a la fe cristiana, no les hizo seguir los preceptos de la ley judía, que involucrarían la circuncisión, vestimenta particular, prácticas, regulaciones de pureza con respecto a los alimentos, la limpieza, y más.

Según nuestra primera lectura de hoy, Pablo tuvo un gran debate y discusión con ellos, pero ninguna de las partes cedió. Se decidió que Pablo y Bernabé irían a Jerusalén y resolverían el problema de una vez por todas. Este fue probablemente el primer Concilio de la Iglesia y de hecho resolvió el problema con compromiso.

De la misma manera, en la Iglesia de hoy establecemos debates, y es por eso que Concilios como el Vaticano II fueron y son tan importantes. Es el Espíritu que actúa a través de toda la Iglesia, como Uno que puede influir en las cosas o cambiarlas y crear la unidad en la Iglesia.

Esa unidad es también el tema de la oración de Jesús en el Evangelio de hoy. Jesús ora para que todos sean uno, los seguidores originales y los que vendrán después. La oración teológica profunda aquí se explica con lógica. Como el Padre y el Hijo son uno, el Padre está en el Hijo y el Hijo en el Padre. Jesús ora para que también podamos ser uno con el Padre y el Hijo... en otras palabras, que seamos conscientes con ellos, que compartamos en su gloria y en su amor.

La raíz del cristianismo es el amor. Serás juzgado por lo bien y lo mucho que has amado. Creo que podemos ser fácilmente perdonados, pero el gran problema es cuánto llevamos el amor de Cristo a nuestro mundo. Si hemos aprendido algo de este tiempo de Pascua, dejemos saber que Dios levantó y glorificó a su Hijo para que sepamos que también podemos ser resucitados y glorificados. Y la oración de Jesús de hoy nos dice cómo.

¿Podemos comenzar a medir nuestros días por cuánto hemos amado y demostrado amor a los demás? Es un desafío. Es el cristianismo. Es la oración de Jesús por nosotros. Son buenas noticias... ¡si solo lo viviéramos!
