From the Pastor...

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today, we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost, traditionally called the birthday of the Church. After these past 50 days of Easter celebration, Pentecost leads us into what is known as Ordinary Time in the Church calendar. Pentecost is a mystery, one of the most beautiful and comforting mysteries of the church... and one that gives us the most strength, the most faith, the most hope and the most love.

“Suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were. Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim.”

Notice that these words describe what we call a mystical experience. The writer is unable to say in literal terms what these people went through because it was not just an ordinary event, but a supernatural one. Mystics talk about their encounters with God in this way, but we receive this gift in a much less dramatic manner. Most of us are infants when we receive the Spirit in Baptism, but we also have the sacrament of Confirmation, which is the point in our lives when we ourselves, not our parents, choose to be Christian, and we ask the Holy Spirit to descend on us again.

We should also keep something in mind: Pentecost happened at a meeting! One of the central events that shaped Christian history and history in general, happened not to an individual off praying alone or to a monk on a mountaintop or to a solitary nun meditating in a chapel. Pentecost happened at a meeting and it happened to a community, to a church congregation assembled for prayer, to a family of faith gathered to wait for God's guidance.

So to find God, to receive God's spirit, it's important that, at times, we pull away from the group, that we set off to the desert, to the chapel, to the lonely place, the quiet, to be alone with God. We see Jesus do exactly that. We meet God there, surely, but we also meet God in the group, the community, the family, at the church gathering: *“For where two or three meet in my name, I shall be there with them!”* These are not in opposition, but complementary, relying on each other to keep our experience of God both deep and pure. And so, we need to continue to go to our Sunday masses. We need to spend time together waiting for God, waiting for a new outflow of heavenly fire that will give us the courage, language, and power we need to make happen in the world what our faith and love envision. And that is what we do at our meeting each and every Sunday.

I wish you and your families a blessed Pentecost.

Desde el Escritorio del Párroco

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Hoy celebramos la fiesta de Pentecostés, tradicionalmente llamada el cumpleaños de la Iglesia. Después de estos últimos 50 días de celebración de Pascua, Pentecostés nos lleva a lo que se conoce como el calendario del Tiempo Ordinario en la Iglesia.

Pentecostés es un misterio, uno de los misterios más bellos y reconfortantes de la iglesia... y uno que nos da la mayor fortaleza, la mayor fe, la mayor esperanza y el mayor amor.

“De repente vino del cielo un ruido como un fuerte viento de conducción, y llenó toda la casa en la que estaban. Entonces se les aparecieron lenguas de fuego, que se separaron y se posaron sobre cada una de ellos. Y todos estaban llenos del Espíritu Santo y comenzaron a hablar en diferentes lenguas, ya que el Espíritu les permitió proclamar”.

Note que estas palabras describen lo que llamamos una experiencia mística. El escritor no puede decir en términos literales por lo que pasó esta gente porque no fue solo un evento ordinario, sino sobrenatural. Los místicos hablan de sus encuentros con Dios de esta manera, pero recibimos este regalo de una manera mucho menos dramática. La mayoría de nosotros somos bebés cuando recibimos el Espíritu en el Bautismo, pero también tenemos el sacramento de la Confirmación, que es el punto en nuestras vidas cuando nosotros mismos, no nuestros padres, elegimos ser cristianos, y le pedimos al Espíritu Santo que descienda en nosotros de nuevo.

También debemos tener algo en mente: ¡Pentecostés sucedió en una reunión! Uno de los eventos centrales que dieron forma a la historia cristiana y la historia en general, no sucedió a un individuo que rezaba solo o a un monje en la cima de una montaña o a una monja solitaria que meditaba en una capilla. Pentecostés sucedió en una reunión y sucedió a una comunidad, a una congregación de la iglesia reunida para orar, a una familia de fe reunida para esperar la guía de Dios.

Entonces, para encontrar a Dios, para recibir el espíritu de Dios, es importante que, a veces, nos alejemos del grupo, que salgamos al desierto, a la capilla, al lugar solitario, al silencio, para estar a solas con Dios. Vemos a Jesús hacer exactamente eso.
