



From the Pastor...

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



A certain Catholic missionary was doing a very good job in his mission village in the African interior. In a few years, he had baptized many people and built a church, a school and a health center. Owing to his strenuous work schedule, he took ill and had to be flown back to his native country in Europe for treatment. After many months, he was well enough to return to Africa. To his surprise and utter disappointment he discovered that the whole village had abandoned his church and turned to a local evangelical preacher. Even the church he built, now had an evangelical signboard in front of it. "What went wrong?" he asked himself. How did his flourishing mission collapse overnight? "What did I do wrong?" he asked his former church members. The truth hit home one day when a woman said to him, "Father, you did a lot for us. You gave our children clothes and built up our village. But there was one thing you did not do. You did not bring us to know Jesus as our personal Lord and Savior." Doing the work of the Lord is great. But knowing the Lord of the work comes first.

Today's gospel is the story of two sisters, Martha, who is busy with the work of the Lord, and Mary, who is more interested in knowing the Lord. For Martha service comes first, for Mary relationship comes first. Like the missionary in our story, Martha must have been shocked to hear the Lord, Himself saying that it is relationship with Him that comes first, for without it our service is meaningless. St. Mark tells us that when Jesus called the apostles to follow Him, he called them for a dual purpose: **"to be with Him and to be sent out to proclaim the message"** (Mark 3:14). The need, on the one hand, to be with the Lord, to know Him, to fellowship with Him and be nourished by His word and, on the other hand, to do the Lord's work, to serve the Lord in others, to proclaim His message of love in word and deed, brings us to a conflict. Which one comes first? How much of my time should I devote to being with the Lord, *in prayer* and listening to God's Word, and how much time to doing the work of the Lord?

The point of the gospel is to challenge our priorities so that we come to see that fellowship with the Lord, being with the Lord and hearing His Word should always precede the work we do for the Lord. Do we have a program of daily fellowship with the Lord? Many people fulfill this by assisting daily in the Eucharist, where they can also hear the Word of God. Others schedule a Holy Hour or quiet time when they can pray and read the Word of God. Whatever way we fulfill this need, today's gospel invites all Christians first to be a 'Mary,' who sits with devotion at the Lord's feet listening to His Word, and then also to be a 'Martha,' who throws herself with energy into the business of serving the Lord.

I wish you all a happy and blessed week ahead.

Lay Pastoral Ministry Institute (LPMI)

An invitation from LPMI: So often people ask how they can grow in their faith. In response to this, then Bishop, Robert N. Lynch initiated the formation of the Lay Pastoral Ministry Institute. The LPMI is a four-year program: an informal year of discernment and three years of formal academic training and spiritual growth. The initial segment of the program, the Year of Discernment, consists of eight Saturday sessions from 9:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. The classes meet at Christ the King Parish, located at 821 S. Dale Mabry Hwy., Tampa. Classes begin on September 14, 2019 and continue once monthly through April 2020. For 20 years, the LPMI has provided education and formation for laity in four areas of formation— human, spiritual, intellectual, and pastoral. The program is designed to enhance personal faith and develop intellectual aptitude to enrich ministry efforts. Our skilled instructors include a variety of priests, deacons, and laity who are active in ministerial roles in our diocese. Desde el Escritorio del Párroco

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo! Cierta misionero católico estaba haciendo un muy buen trabajo en el pueblo donde estaba misionando en el interior de África. En pocos años, había bautizado a muchas personas y había construido una iglesia, una escuela y un centro de salud. Debido a su arduo horario de trabajo, se enfermó y tuvo que regresar a su país natal en Europa para recibir tratamiento. Después de muchos meses, estuvo lo suficientemente bien como para regresar a África. Para su sorpresa y absoluta decepción, descubrió que toda la aldea había abandonado su iglesia y se había ido con un predicador evangélico local. Incluso la iglesia que él construyó, ahora tenía un letrero evangélico en frente de ella. "¿Qué salió mal?", se preguntó a sí mismo. ¿Cómo colapsó su floreciente misión de la noche a la mañana? "¿Qué hice mal?", le preguntó a los ex miembros de su iglesia. La verdad llegó cuando una mujer le dijo: "Padre, hiciste mucho por nosotros. Le diste a nuestros hijos ropa y construiste nuestro pueblo. Pero hubo una cosa que no hiciste. No nos hiciste conocer a Jesús como nuestro Señor y Salvador personal". Hacer la obra del Señor es grandioso. Pero conocer al Señor de la obra es lo primero.

El evangelio de hoy es la historia de dos hermanas, Martha, que está ocupada con la obra del Señor, y María, que está más interesada en conocer al Señor. Para Martha el servicio es lo primero, para María lo primero es la relación. Al igual que el misionero en nuestra historia, Martha debe haberse sorprendido al escuchar al Señor. Él mismo dice que lo primero es la relación con Él, ya que sin él nuestro servicio carece de sentido.

San Marcos nos dice que cuando Jesús llamó a los apóstoles para que lo siguieran, los llamó con un doble propósito: "estar con Él y ser enviado para proclamar el mensaje" (Marcos 3:14). La necesidad, por un lado, de estar con el Señor, de conocerlo, de tener comunión con Él y ser alimentados por Su palabra y, por otro lado, de hacer la obra del Señor, de servir al Señor en los demás, de proclamar. Su mensaje de amor en palabra y obra, nos lleva a un conflicto. ¿Cuál viene primero? ¿Cuánto tiempo debo dedicar a estar con el Señor, orando y escuchando la Palabra de Dios, y cuánto tiempo para hacer la obra del Señor?
