

From the Pastor...

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This week the church invites us to meditate on the theme of prayer.

In today's first reading, we have the familiar conversation between God and Abraham, in which Abraham, upon learning that God will destroy Sodom and Gomorrah because of their sins, pleads, even bargains with Him to reconsider. The notion that there were not even 10 righteous people in those cities, tells us just how far they had turned from God and embraced evil. At the end, God saves the one just person, Lot ...and his family, while the whole cities of Sodom and Gomorrah were wiped off the face of the earth.

Prayer can be specific, such as a petition, a thanksgiving, or it can be a conversation, a dialogue with God, as seen in the example of Abraham. Prayer should be an integral part of our lives as human beings. It is the action through which we keep in touch with the Creator. It is necessary to praise, thank and adore God...all different forms of prayer. Jesus reminds us through His teachings that prayer is not only the petitioning of God for our needs and intentions, as He taught the Apostles in the "Our Father", but also one prays by spending time with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, like Mary Magdalene who listened to Jesus by sitting at His feet.

God is a loving Father who knows our needs before we ask Him. He takes care of us in different ways and through different means. We live in a fast paced society which wants instant results. People expect God to react to them in the manner and timing they, themselves set. If they don't get their way they complain and turn away from God. But even in temporal life it doesn't work that way. God always cares for us and wants everything good for our sake. He created us in His love; a love so intense that He sacrificed His only Son, Jesus Christ for our sake. It is our responsibility to pursue a loving relationship with God, through prayer...which is our intimate relationship with Him.

Prayer is essential not only for individuals but also for Christian family life. To remain faithful in marriage, spouses need to pray, not only individually, but together. They need to thank God and offer intercessory prayers for each other, for their children and loved ones. Daily prayer will help married couples to celebrate and reverence God's vision of human sexuality and to honor life from conception to natural death. It draws them closer to God and to each other. Here is St. John Marie Vianney's advice to a married couple: "Spend three minutes praising and thanking God for all you have. Spend three minutes asking God's pardon for your sins and presenting your needs before Him. Spend three minutes reading the Bible and listening to God in silence. And do this every day"

So this week, if you haven't already, try to develop your relationship with God using the pattern that Jesus taught us - address God in an intimate way, lavish praise and honor, make your petitions, and be persistent and consistent in doing so.

I wish you all a blessed week ahead.

Desde el Escritorio del Párroco

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo!

Esta semana la iglesia nos invita a meditar sobre el tema de la oración.

En la primera lectura de hoy, tenemos la conversación familiar entre Dios y Abraham, en la cual Abraham, al enterarse de que Dios destruirá a Sodoma y Gomorra a causa de sus pecados, suplica, incluso negocia con Él para que lo reconsideré. La noción de que no había ni siquiera 10 personas justas en esas ciudades, nos dice hasta qué punto se habían alejado de Dios y habían abrazado el mal. Al final, Dios salva a la persona justa, Lot ... y a su familia, mientras que todas las ciudades de Sodoma y Gomorra fueron borradas de la faz de la tierra.

La oración puede ser específica, como una petición, una acción de gracias, o puede ser una conversación, un diálogo con Dios, como se ve en el ejemplo de Abraham. La oración debe ser una parte integral de nuestras vidas como seres humanos. Es la acción a través de la cual nos mantenemos en contacto con el Creador. Es necesario alabar, agradecer y adorar a Dios ... todas las diferentes formas de oración. Jesús nos recuerda a través de sus enseñanzas que la oración no es solo una petición a Dios por nuestras necesidades e intenciones, como enseñó a los Apóstoles en el "Padre Nuestro", sino que también se ora al pasar tiempo con Jesús en el Santísimo Sacramento, como María Magdalena, quien escuchó a Jesús sentado a sus pies.

Dios es un Padre amoroso que conoce nuestras necesidades antes de que se las pidamos. Él nos cuida de diferentes maneras y por diferentes medios. Vivimos en una sociedad de ritmo rápido que quiere resultados instantáneos. La gente espera que Dios reaccione a ellos de la manera y el tiempo que ellos mismos establezcan. Si no se salen con la suya, se quejan y se alejan de Dios. Pero incluso en la vida temporal no funciona de esa manera. Dios siempre se preocupa por nosotros y quiere todo lo bueno para nuestro bien. El nos creó en su amor; un amor tan intenso que sacrificó a su único Hijo, Jesucristo por nosotros. Es nuestra responsabilidad buscar una relación amorosa con Dios, a través de la oración ... que es nuestra relación íntima con él.

La oración es esencial no solo para los individuos sino también para la vida familiar cristiana. Para permanecer fieles en el matrimonio, los esposos deben orar, no solo individualmente, sino juntos. Necesitamos agradecer a Dios y ofrecer oraciones de intercesión, por los hijos y seres queridos. La oración diaria ayudará a las parejas casadas a celebrar y respetar la visión de la sexualidad humana de Dios y honrar la vida desde la concepción hasta la muerte natural. Los acerca más a Dios y el uno al otro. Aquí está el consejo de St. Juan María Vianney a una pareja casada: "Pasa tres minutos alabando y agradeciendo a Dios por todo lo que tienes. Pasa tres minutos pidiendo el perdón de Dios por sus pecados y presentando sus necesidades ante Él. Pase tres minutos leyendo la Biblia y escuchando a Dios en silencio. Y has esto todos los días."


