From the Pastor...

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



In the today's gospel we see seventy two disciples being sent out. This is quite unique. All the gospels mention that Jesus commissioned His twelve disciples to continue his mission, however, only Luke tells us about the seventy two disciples being sent out. There must be a reason for this. Jesus says that the harvest is great and there are not enough people to do the necessary work. At the same time, Luke wants to tell us that this mission is not only for priests and religious, but is the responsibility of all believers. This is very much in keeping with what Vatican II has expressed. Speaking about the laity, the Council Fathers also have said that it is the right and duty of every baptized person to preach the gospel.

How are we going to do this? I have often heard people say that they don't feel qualified to participate in this mission. Many can't come to terms with the fact that the work of Jesus requires, above all, a heart that is passionate enough to share with others what it has already experienced... that is, the life-giving Holy Spirit of God, living within it.

Through Luke, Jesus is saying that we can continue His mission by being involved, not only in great, well organized and well attended programs but also by the individual work of ordinary people, doing ordinary things and being faithful to their responsibilities.

This is the reason why we cannot live our Christian faith on our own. It is too difficult. It is too hard. This is therefore, the reason why we need to be together as a parish and as a diocese. To be able to put into practice the mission of Jesus, we need the support of a team. There is room for everybody and we all have gifts and talents which can help build up our local parish community. Every little gesture of kindness, every single act of service to others, every word of encouragement helps us to become more aware of our mission and gives us the necessary impetus to live out our calling. These simple and ordinary acts can make a difference in the lives of so many.

So let us pray: *"Lord Jesus Christ, I thank You for my life and for all the good qualities that You have given to me. Help me to use these qualities for my own growth and to help others. May I be a witness of Your Resurrection, wherever I may be. I know that You honor and bless whatever good I do. May I be a source of Your blessing to everyone I meet each day of my life. Amen."*

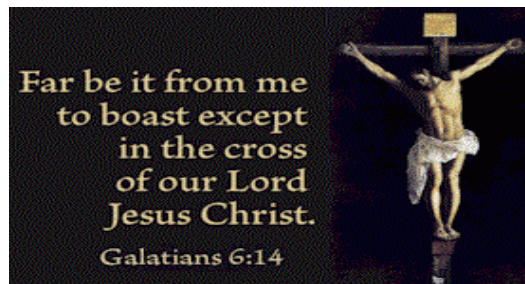

En el evangelio de hoy vemos a setenta y dos discípulos siendo enviados. Esto es bastante único. Todos los evangelios mencionan que Jesús comisionó a sus doce discípulos para continuar su misión, sin embargo, solo Lucas nos cuenta acerca de los setenta y dos discípulos que fueron enviados.
