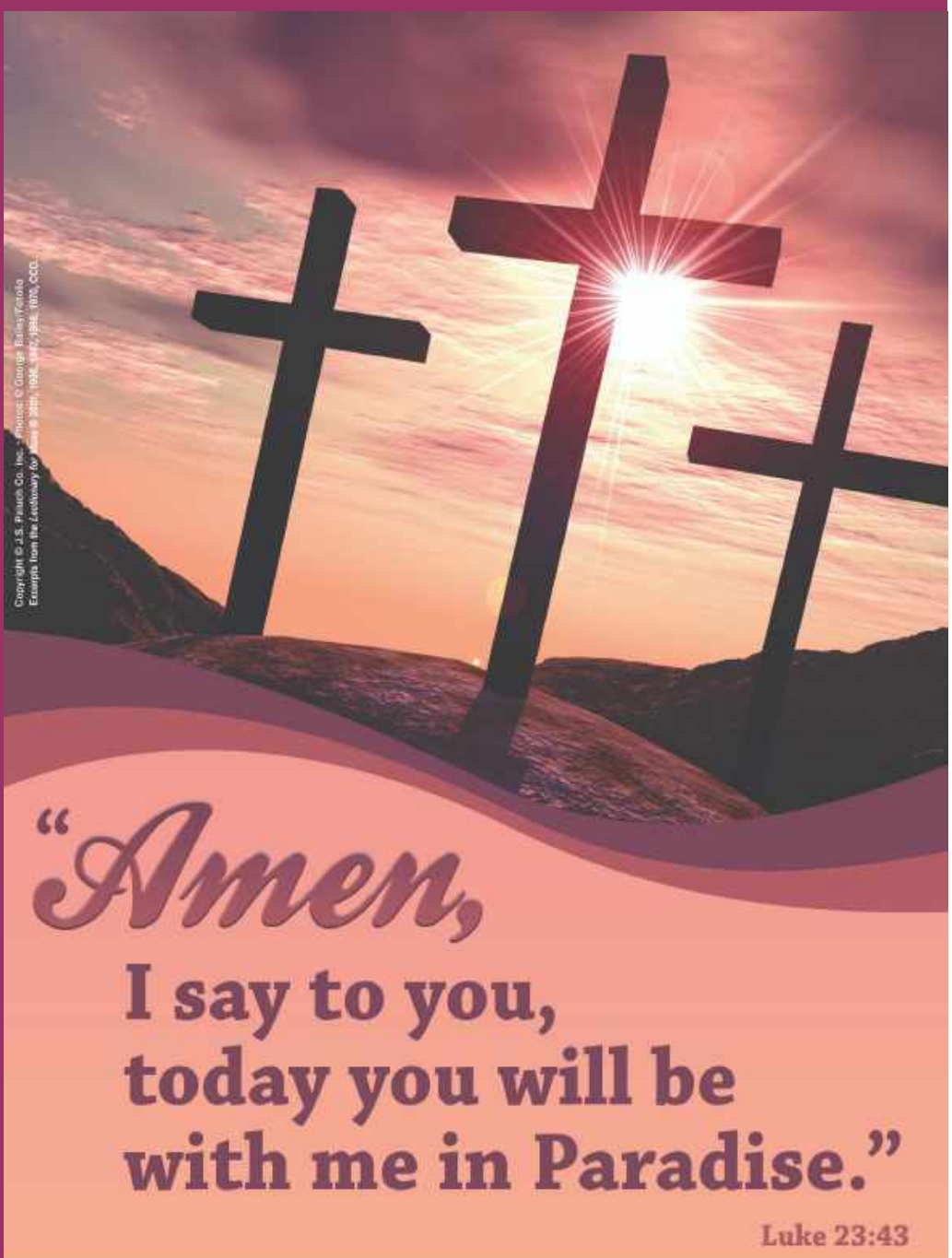

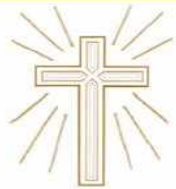

From the Pastor...

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today we celebrate the Feast of Christ the King. We celebrate Christ, risen, ascended and glorified. We give thanks to God for all He has done for us through Jesus and for the difference Jesus makes in our lives.

We celebrate the Kingship of Christ ...but what sort of Kingship is it that we're celebrating? Our Gospel reading gives us a vivid picture upon which to reflect.

The scene is certainly not what we would expect to see illustrating kingship, power and authority. Here are no fine robes but a naked and scarred body. His crown has no jewels, only vicious thorns. On His hands there are no rings of power, just the nails which fix Him to a wooden cross – no golden throne. There are no courtiers or servants around Him – just two criminals sharing His fate and an assorted crowd of soldiers and ghoulish spectators who taunt and mock Him.

But before we turn away from this ghastly picture of cruelty and humiliation, we see the words: "This is the King of the Jews" - and we hear the voice of an unlikely believer... "remember me when You come into Your kingdom". Someone here has caught a glimpse of the glory that is hidden by the awfulness of this torture. And we hear another voice, the voice of authority coming from the defeat of the cross, "Today you will be with Me in Paradise".

It is no mistake that the Church chooses these words: "Today you will be with Me in Paradise", to be the very last words of the gospel, on the very last Sunday of the liturgical year. These words, which are the fulfillment of all we could ever want, all we could ever hope for, ring in our ears. And we want to cry out with the very same words of the people who welcomed Jesus into Jerusalem: "Hosanna in the highest, blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest."

As we celebrate the Kingship of Christ today, Jesus invites us, as He did 2000 years ago: "Take My yoke upon you, and learn from Me; for I am gentle and humble of heart." (Matthew 11:29). Today is the day to ask ourselves how deeply we have responded, as individuals and as a community, to this invitation to cultivate the mind of Christ in our dealings with one another, especially in our dealings with those we perceive to be different from us. This is the way to show in our daily lives that Jesus Christ is indeed our king: by cultivating and living out in our lives the gentle and humble mind of Christ.

And so, let us conclude with a prayer: *Jesus, meek and humble of heart, make our hearts like unto Thine.*

I wish you all a happy and blessed week ahead.

Desde el Escritorio del Párroco

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo!



Hoy celebramos la fiesta de Cristo Rey. Celebramos a Cristo, resucitado, ascendido y glorificado. Damos gracias a Dios por todo lo que ha hecho por nosotros a través de Jesús y por toda la diferencia que Jesús hace en nuestras vidas.

Celebramos el reinado de Cristo ... pero ¿qué tipo de reinado es lo que estamos celebrando? Nuestra lectura del Evangelio nos da una imagen vívida sobre la cual reflexionar.

La escena ciertamente no es lo que esperaríamos ver ilustrando la realeza, el poder y la autoridad. Aquí no hay túnicas finas sino un cuerpo desnudo y cicatrizado. Su corona no tiene joyas, solo espinas. En sus manos no hay anillos de poder, solo los clavos que lo sujetan a una cruz de madera, no hay trono de oro. No hay sirvientes a su alrededor, solo dos delincuentes que comparten su destino y una multitud de soldados y espectadores macabros que se ríen de él y se burlan de él.

Pero antes de alejarnos de esta horrible imagen de crueldad y humillación, vemos las palabras: "Este es el Rey de los judíos", y escuchamos la voz de un creyente poco probable ... "acuérdate de mí cuando vengas a tu reino". Alguien aquí ha vislumbrado la gloria que está oculta por el horror de esta tortura. Y escuchamos otra voz, la voz de autoridad que viene de la derrota de la cruz, "Hoy estarás conmigo en el paraíso".

No es un error que la Iglesia elija estas palabras: "Hoy estarás conmigo en el paraíso", para ser las últimas palabras del evangelio, el último domingo del año litúrgico. Estas palabras, que son el cumplimiento de todo lo que podríamos desear, todo lo que podríamos esperar, suenan en nuestros oídos. Y queremos clamar con las mismas palabras de las personas que recibieron a Jesús en Jerusalén: "Hosanna en las alturas, bendito sea el que viene en el nombre del Señor. Hosanna en lo más alto."

Hoy, mientras celebramos el reinado de Cristo, Jesús nos invita, como lo hizo hace 2000 años: "Toma mi yugo y aprende de mí; porque soy gentil y humilde de corazón" (Mateo 11:29). Hoy es el día de preguntarnos qué tan profundamente hemos respondido, como individuos y como comunidad, a esta invitación a cultivar la mente de Cristo en nuestros tratos mutuos, especialmente en nuestros tratos con aquellos que percibimos que son diferentes a nosotros. Esta es la manera de mostrar en nuestra vida diaria que Jesucristo es de hecho nuestro rey: al cultivar y vivir en nuestras vidas la mente gentil y humilde de Cristo.

Y así, concluyamos con una oración: Jesús, manso y humilde de corazón, haz que nuestro corazón sea como el tuyo.
